Nominations

The sale is open to all Droughtmaster Breeders including members and non-members.

Vendors need to nominate via their chosen agent who is also an accredited AuctionsPlus assessor. Assessors may be found via "Find Assessors" tab on the AuctionsPlus homepage <https://auctionsplus.com.au/assessors/livestock>

Conditions of Entry

1. All entries are to be female.
2. There is no minimum lot size, however all lots are required to be assessed. It is at the discretion of the assessor as to what they determine is suitable to travel for and assess.
3. Female entry requirements:
 - a. Females maximum age is 10 years
 - b. Females over 36 months of age and/or 4 teeth or more must be PTIC or have a calf at foot.
 - c. Females PTIC or with a calf at foot sired by a breed other than Droughtmaster are acceptable, however joining details must be included in lot description.
 - d. Females can be pre-classified by a Droughtmaster classifier (please contact Droughtmaster Australia for a classifiers list) to be suitable for D1 or D2 registration with Droughtmaster Australia by the purchaser.
 - e. Classified D rated females can be included for sale, this classification may be included in the lot description.
 - f. PTIC females can be pregnancy tested by the vendor or their chosen veterinarian, with the pregnancy status clearly described in the lot description. Droughtmaster Australia strongly recommends the use of veterinarians or accredited pregnancy technicians.
4. All females should reflect the Droughtmaster Standard of Excellence. The Droughtmaster Standard of Excellence is available on www.droughtmaster.com.au
5. The AuctionsPlus assessors or the Droughtmaster Sale Committee have the right to reject entries that do not reflect the Droughtmaster Standard Excellence.
6. The auction sale will be run online by AuctionsPlus. All animals are to be nominated, assessed, photographed and videoed to enable the catalogue to go live by one week prior to the sale date.
7. The lots will be sold geographically as per current AuctionsPlus format i.e., starting at the Far North down to Far South then over to WA.
8. Selling Agents will be rebating half of one percent of their commission to Droughtmaster Australia as a marketing and promotion levy. The Selling Agent is to contact Droughtmaster Australia for a selling agreement This agreement is to be signed by the agent and returned to Droughtmaster Australia.
