

Duaringa Station Feedlot Outline for DMCC 2021

Space available for the Droughtmaster Society: Approx 500 head (this may increase depending on requirements for our own cattle)

- Pen size varies: 100 SCU, 150 SCU, 200 SCU
- Minimum 1 deck per client - due to this small number, cattle will be boxed with one another. However, heifers and steers will be kept separate.
- 120-130 days on feed
- Enter feedlot between Xmas & New Year 2020
- Induction within 7 days of arrival
- Cattle must:
 - have NLIS tags
 - be dehorned
 - be in sound physical condition
- Zoetis have confirmed they will come on board to sponsor the following cattle health treatments:
 - Synovex TBA HGP (if required)
 - Bovishield
 - Rhinoguard
 - Dectomax
 - Longrange
 - Botulinum
- Duaringa station recommends 3 Day (BEF) Vaccine (recommended but not compulsory) - Two injections of the vaccine 2 weeks to 6 months apart. Therefore 1 injection must be at least 2 weeks prior to feedlot entry.
- Due to the potential number of participants, there will be only 1 opportunity to draft/select/tag the chosen competition cattle. However, clients will be given opportunities to walk through the pen prior to final selection day. Final selection will take place 2-3 weeks prior to the competition (weather and/or other issues permitting)
- If there are not enough females to fill a minimum 100 head pen, we may not be able to take cattle for that class.
- With cooperation with the Droughtmaster Society, we may hold an Average Daily Weight Gain competition between Droughtmaster participants with the first weigh in at induction and the final at selection.
- Invoicing will be on a monthly basis
- Cartage from Duaringa Station Feedlot to CQLX will be organised by Duaringa Station Feedlot but on charged to the client.
- Ration price will be determined by late November 2020.
- Participants will be responsible for nominating their own cattle.
